Piston Foundation Partners Again with Bring a Trailer to Benefit Cars for Piston Scholars Campaign with Car Donation from Adam's Polishes

In Continued Partnership with BaT, a 1960 Willys Wagon will be Auctioned to Benefit the Piston Foundation Scholarship Program

GREENWICH, Conn. (July 12, 2023) – The Piston Foundation, whose mission is to bring more young people into the trades of the collector car industry, recently launched the Cars for Piston Scholars campaign, in partnership with Bring a Trailer, a digital auction platform. The car initially auctioned to benefit the Piston Foundation was the famous "Gimlet Z" – a lime-yellow 1973 Datsun 240Z donated by BaT.

On July 12, 2023, the second Cars for Piston Scholars charity auction will take place on bringatrailer.com. The collector car up for sale is a rugged 1960 Willys Wagon, donated by Adam Pitale of Adam's Polishes. Bidding will begin on July 12, and end on July 19.

The Piston Foundation accepts donations of classic, historic, and vintage cars to be auctioned to benefit the Foundation's scholarship program, giving collectors a unique way to make a positive impact in the car community.

One hundred percent of the auction price goes directly to tech-school scholarships for aspiring collector car technicians. These scholarships provide tuition assistance that helps young people turn their collector car interest into a career. Additionally, Bring a Trailer donates 100 percent of its buyer's fee to the scholarship program to maximize the positive impact of each auction.

Together, the Piston Foundation, a 501(c)(3) organization, Bring a Trailer, and the community of donors work to support the next generation of collector car technicians.

The initial Cars for Piston Scholars auction earned the Piston Foundation a grand total of \$135,753 – enough to create scholarships for 27 aspiring technicians. The Foundation's goal for 2023 is to award 50 scholarships. Ten scholarships were awarded in 2022.

The classic 1960 Willys Wagon is finished in DOT Yellow over a brown leather with wooden floor slats. The drivetrain includes a F134 inline 4-cylinder engine, a 3-speed manual transmission, and a dual-speed transfer case. It has been restored with new paint, a reupholstered interior, new gauges, and more. In 1960, only 1175 of these 4-cylinder Wagons were produced, making this survivor considerably more rare than other vintage off-roaders.

"Of course, since it was donated by Adam's Polishes, the wagon is spotless," said Jeff Mason, president and COO of the Piston Foundation.

Car care has been Adam Pitale's passion since he was 10 years old, polishing friends' cars and motorcycles. He started Adam's Polishes in California in 2000. Since then, the company has relocated to Thornton, Colorado, and has continued to sell premium car care products all over the world. The company manufactures a range of products including interior and exterior automotive cleaners, waxes, polishes, ceramics, and other car-care accessories for cars, trucks, RVs and boats. Its parent company today is Recochem.

"I buy and sell cars on Bring a Trailer all the time," said Pitale. "And I have a tremendous amount of respect for what the Piston Foundation is doing. I'm just thrilled to death to be involved with something that's going to help kids get to do what their passion is for a living, and
